SEASONAL MINUTE-TO-WIN-IT

SPRING
Jelly Bean Toss Up:
Needed:
□ Jelly beans
Choose 2 volunteers, one from each side of the aisle. Each player is given a cup full of jelly beans. They have one minute to see how many they can toss into the air and catch in their mouth.
SUMMER:
Beach Ball Pass:
These games are designed for an area where the ladies are sitting in rows with an aisle between them.
Needed:
□ 2 beach balls.
Starting the ball at the front row, the teams have one minute to tap the ball down each row, zig zagging the ball all the way to the back row without skipping rows or groups of people. The first one done wins. (If your group of chairs is small, you may have to extend the game by reversing the ball at the back and sending it back through the rows to the front).
Another summer idea:
Beach Ball Volleyball (This one's a tradition for us!) Play between the seats. One side of the aisle against the other. You have to be a little flexible on the calls since there's no net. If it lands in the aisle and clearly is not on either side, it's a do-over. There's not to be any standing on the chairs, and they must stay relatively in/near their seats (of course they can pop up and down). AND NO SPIKING! LOL!
FALL:
Bobbing for Apples - foot style:
Needed:
□ 2 chairs
□ Apples
 2 buckets of water with the same number of apples in each bucket (can add some ice if you want to increase the craziness).
$\ \square$ 2 empty buckets or baskets for them to drop the apples into.
Choose 2 volunteers, one from each side of the aisle. Using only their feet, the players have one minute to get as many apples as they can out of one bucket and into the other empty bucket.

The player with the most apples wins.

WINTER:

Do You Want to Build a Snowman?

Needed:

- □ 2 rolls of toilet paper
- □ 2 sets of paper eyes with double-sided tape on the back for attaching
- $\ \square$ 2 paper noses with double-sided tape on the back for attaching
- □ 2 scarves (optional)

Choose four volunteers, two from each side of the aisle. The players must build a snowman by wrapping their team member in the whole roll of toilet paper. They may not stop until the roll is empty!

The teams have one minute to get their teammate wrapped and decorated with the eyes, nose and scarf. If they don't get finished, the one closest to being done wins. If they finish before the minute, the first one finished wins.
